One Another Ministries International provides professional services to Christian organizations and workers who are in need. **There is no charge for the services we provide.** This is possible because all costs associated with this ministry are covered by the generosity and sacrifice of our regular supporters.

Often, the Christian workers and organizations who receive help want to show their appreciation by contributing to the ongoing work of this ministry. These contributions are, of course, always accepted and appreciated. They are applied toward caring for missionaries and Christian workers both proactively and in response to difficulties, through the collective work of One Another Ministries, thus ensuring that help will be available to others in the future.

Guidelines for donations. In planning their donation, some of those receiving help have asked what it costs One Another to make this help available. This information is provided here strictly as a courtesy to those wishing to contribute, and should in no way be construed as a list of charges for our services.

Services provided in residence: One Another Ministries spends approximately \$575 per day to provide professional services to an individual in residence at one of our facilities (\$675 per day for a couple).

Services provided at the point of need: When our staff travels to work with teams, organizations, or individuals, it costs us approximately \$475 per day for each One Another staff member involved, plus travel expenses.

Please be assured that we want all Christian workers and organizations to receive the help they might need, and the ability to contribute is never considered when scheduling services.
