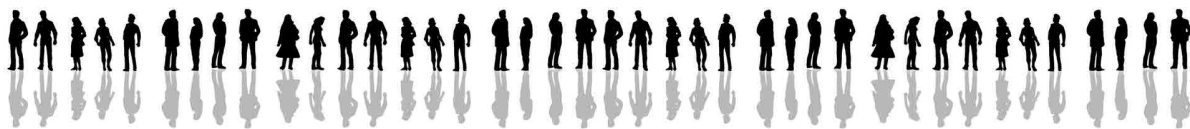

January 2015 Ministry Report

Who?



In 2014, One Another Ministries provided services for **313** missionaries and international Christian workers.

- ❑ **Mission agencies** – These workers were sent out by 48 different agencies
 - ❖ Sixteen of them were new for us
- ❑ **Level of intervention** – Services were provided to:
 - ❖ 27 entire organizations, 10 field or ministry team, 1 family, 19 couples, and 75 individuals.
- ❑ **How they were referred to us**
 - ❖ 69% contacted us directly
 - ❖ 26% were referred by their sending agency
 - ❖ 5% were mandated by their sending agency

What?



- ❑ **Proactive services**
 - ❖ 75% of our work was **primarily proactive** in nature – helping ministries be more effective
 - ❖ The most common proactive services were: training, consulting, debriefing, encouragement
- ❑ **Training events for groups**
 - ❖ During the year we provided **eight training events**
 - ❖ **158 international Christian workers** received training at these events
- ❑ **Responsive services**
 - ❖ 25% of ministry time was **primarily responsive** in nature – dealing with problems
 - ❖ The most common responsive services were: counseling, consulting, conflict intervention, traumatic incident or crisis intervention
- ❑ **Hospitality and lodging**
 - ❖ When receiving services at our ministry centre, missionaries required housing 73% of the time.
 - ❖ This resulted in our providing **342 guest nights of hospitality**.

Where?

Where did the clients come from?

- ❑ **Nationalities** – We worked with Christian workers **originating from 23 countries** or regions
 - ❖ 1 of these was new for us
- ❑ **Countries of service** – These workers are serving God in **32 countries**
 - ❖ Impacting 3 of these for the first time



Where were we?

- ❑ 43% of the time one or more of our team traveled to the point of need
- ❑ 57% of the time they came to us
